

16 – 19 Tuition Funding Statement

The 16 – 19 tuition Fund is a one-off payment for the academic year 2020/21 provided by the government to support those students whose learning has been disrupted by issues relating to Covid-19.

The funding is targeted to support those students who have not yet achieved a grade 4 or above in English and/or mathematics. Students will be provided with additional support in small groups of 3 or 4 students. Students in other subject areas may also be supported.

Disruption students may face or will have faced includes:

- Assessments deferred due to lockdown or self-isolation.
- Falling behind in learning due to long or multiple periods of self-isolation.
- Not being able to complete external examinations due to positive COVID-19 cases.

All Saints Sixth Form College will utilise the funding to provide additional support and resources for those students who have not yet achieved a grade 4 in maths or English.

Targeted student intervention will be prioritised as follows:

- Students yet to achieve a grade 4 in English and/or maths on a level 2 pathway.
- Students yet to achieve a grade 4 in English and/or maths on a level 3 pathway.

Priority will be given to those who are considered to be most disadvantaged based on socio-economic background, SEND status and volume of disruption to learning as a result of COVID-19.

Funding will be used in the following ways:

- Allocation of maths English TA's to run additional small group classes during the day and after school.
- Purchase of additional resources to support students.
- Facilitation of additional classes for small numbers of students during the day and after school.

This statement is in line with the Government guidance and has been published to demonstrate how this additional funding will be utilised in the academic year 2020/21. This document may be updated to reflect any changes in ESFA guidance.
