Entry requirements


To study A-Level subjects you will need 4 GCSE's at grade 5 and above.

To study Applied General qualifications you will need 4 GCSE's at grade 4 and above.

Applications can be made online www.allsaintssixthformcollege.org.uk/apply. Once your application is received, you will be invited for an interview. An offer will then be made which clearly explains the grades that will be required to study your chosen courses.

For students who need to improve their GCSE grades, a one year, level 2 programme is available which includes qualifications in Hospitality, Digital Media and Financial Management in addition to GCSE English Language and Mathematics.

RAISING ASPIRATIONS

Academic progress is strengthened by our Accelerate Programme. There are a wide variety of opportunities for students to become involved with employers and HE providers.

We are proud to be a part of the following programmes:

The Girls Network – Each year a number of our female students in year 12 are mentored by a professional female linked to the area of business they are interested in. Through a professional mentoring programme, students are able to discuss career options and gather advice and information on their chosen career pathway.

“My professional mentor was really amazing and I enjoyed catching up with her each month. She really supported me in learning more about her job role and also helped me with my application to university”.

The University of Liverpool Scholars Programme – students selected will work with an academic tutor from the university and with undergraduate students to complete a project which mirrors expectations of an undergraduate student. Successful completion of the course leads to a reduced UCAS offer of up to one grade and a guaranteed bursary.

“Being part of the Scholars Programme gave me a real insight into university life. The support I received with my personal statement was invaluable and it gave me a real sense of achievement when I received an offer from the university”.

The Aspire Programme – our potential Oxford and Cambridge applicants are invited to join this programme, where they are provided with advice and guidance throughout the whole Oxbridge application process, from choosing a course and college to writing a personal statement and preparing for the entrance test. Students will be mentored by Oxbridge undergraduates and also have the opportunity to spend a few days at the University of Oxford.

“Having the opportunity to take part in the Aspire Programme really supported me and made me realise that I can achieve and gain a place at a top university”.

Pathways to Law, Business and Finance and Engineering – these bespoke programmes are facilitated by the Sutton Trust and support students to prepare for entry into each profession.

In addition to the above programmes, we also have very strong links with local HE providers and all students will have the opportunity to visit at least one university as well as taking part in lectures, seminars and various subject specific events. We are well supported by universities who offer workshops on a wide range of subjects such as planning for HE, writing a personal statements and applying for student finance.
